The Washington-Baltimore Mass Spectrometry Discussion Group (WBMSDG) will be awarding grants to outstanding young investigators to support travel to the 64th ASMS meeting in San Antonio, TX. The award is open to undergraduate and graduate students at all levels in laboratories and institutions traditionally associated with the WBMSDG; approximate boundaries are Richmond and Charlottesville on the South and Newark, Delaware on the North. Three awards will be made.

Applicants should submit a **single PDF** file that combines:

1. Travel Grant 2016 Application form (includes a checklist)
2. Electronic copy of ASMS abstract
3. Evidence of abstract acceptance by ASMS indicating the presentation format (e.g., poster, oral, etc.)
4. CV or resume
5. Two-page summary of research project (figures can be included)
